He has been the Judge for various photography contest including the 2010 South Texas Pro Classic sponsored by the Valley Land Fund and the 2011 District 2A-2 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools (TAPPS) Art Contest.

He has taught week-long workshops in Adobe Photoshop CS, Adobe Lightroom and Digital Photography. His landscape and wildlife images from around the world are represented by KAC Productions in The Woodlands. Among the many places he has visited to photograph, East Africa and Antarctica are by far his favorites.
